Important upcoming events:


- 1. June 26th Captains Prize Day at Chevin Golf Club. Full details available on the website.

Next big event is my Captain's Day at Chevin Golf Club, June 26th. The format is four ball betterball. Bacon butties on arrival


and Fish and chips after the golf. First tee 1-00 pm Some great prizes and all for £35 per head.
